Equipment Program Prescriber Update

Equipment In-Scope List

The Equipment Program - Equipment In-Scope List has been recently reviewed to reflect current practice and terminology. Key changes include:

- Some items that have always been considered "in-scope" are now listed
- In some instances, the groups of equipment have been changed and reference to product names have been removed
- Some groupings of equipment types (e.g. type 1, type 2, type 3 etc) have been redefined. Definitions can be found in the in-scope list as you hover over the equipment type and on the updated Equipment Item Types Document
- A prescriber type "orthotist" has been added
- Note that the hyperlinks to relevant supporting documents have been removed to enable compatibility on the DES website (soon to be launched)

In line with the changes to the in-scope list, the DES catalogue will also be updated over the next few months.

Approved Prescriber Status

Changes have been made to the Approved Prescriber Status for some items related to bed prescription. A once-off Approved Prescriber registration process will be undertaken within the relevant DCSI agencies until the 11th December 2015.

Equipment Tender Range

DES recently completed a tender process for our most frequently prescribed non-customised items from the warehouse. The new tender range includes a range of existing & new products. A consolidated list of these products is available on the DES interface under Equipment Tender Range. Details about specifications can be found on the DES online catalogue.

Electric Adjustable Bed Comparison Table

DES has collated summaries of specifications for the stock range of electric beds and mattresses to support compatibility of products when considering prescribing for clients at risk of entrapment.
